**1. HOW TO ENTER:** To enter, complete and submit an Entry Form during the contest period that begins at 12:01 AM (Eastern Time) on Monday, October 16, 2023 and ends at 11:59 PM (Eastern Time) on Friday, November 17, 2023, and either electronically transmit your entry to [teacherreuseexchange@gmail.com](mailto:teacherreuseexchange@gmail.com) or mail your entry to 1470 Harburn Court, Cumming, GA 30041. Contest is limited to one entry per person.

Entries containing any reference to alcohol or nudity, or which appear to be inappropriate, indecent or obscene, as determined by Teacher Reuse Exchange, Inc. (“Sponsors”), in their sole discretion, will be judged ineligible. All submissions become the exclusive property of Sponsors, and none will be acknowledged or returned. repurpose, and reuse of new and gently used teacher, school, community, and business discards. Winners will be determined by a panel of Judges selected by Sponsors on or about Monday, November 20, 2023, from all eligible entries received. Winners will be notified by email or telephone.

**3. ELIGIBILITY:** Contest open to all children in elementary, middle, and high schools in Forsyth County public and private schools. All federal, state and local laws and regulations apply. You are not authorized to participate in the contest if you are not located within Forsyth County.
